



Chaffee County Commissioners Meeting
April 2, 2021

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic and State and County safer-at-home orders, these minutes have been taken remotely via Zoom meeting. Some County staff, representatives from other governments and government agencies, and others from the public attend, including participating in the public hearing portion of the meeting, remotely via Zoom meeting as well.

A. Call to Order

The Special meeting of the Board of Commissioners was held on April 2, 2021, at the Chaffee County Courthouse. Board members present were Commissioner Keith Baker (remotely), Chairman Greg Felt, Commissioner Rusty Granzella.

Others present in person were Director of General Administration Bob Christiansen, Director of Finance Dan Short, County Attorney Jennifer Davis, Public Affairs Officer Beth Helmke, and IT Ethan Smith.

Others present remotely were Assistant County Attorney Daniel Tom and Deputy County Clerk Barbara Tidd.

Following the Pledge of Allegiance, Chairman Felt called the meeting to order at 9:02 a.m.

B. Regular Agenda Items

1. Discuss options for recycling services across Chaffee County and its municipalities.

Chair Felt welcomed Christian Academy's 4th and 5th grade classes attending the meeting, introduced this matter, and opened the discussion regarding options for recycling services across Chaffee County and its municipalities.

Each of the Commissioners spoke followed by Director Christiansen.
