I. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 am.

II. Approval of Agenda

Motion was made by Rhoads, seconded by Davis, to approve the agenda as amended. Motion carried unanimously.

III. Approval of November 3, 2022 Minutes

Motion was made by Brown, seconded by Rhoads, to approve the minutes of the November 3, 2022 meeting as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

IV. Commissioner's Report -- Commissioner Baker

Commissioner Baker reported on attending the State Transportation Advisory Committee and Regional Transportation Board meetings. Soon they will be advertising and collecting bids for projects scheduled for 2024 and 2025 including a new signal on Highway 24 at the south end of Buena Vista and a roundabout at the junction of Highways 50 and 291 in Salida.

He also mentioned there are 10 Colorado counties and municipalities, including Chaffee County, working together to block an attempt to re-open the Tennessee Pass rail to preclude moving toxic and/or environmentally dangerous products along this line.

V. Old Business

A. Update on Transit

Andi Wilkerson spoke on behalf of Hank Martin and reported the Chaffee Shuttle received \$10,500 from the Marijuana Excise Tax Advisory Board, as well as other 501(c)3 funds for 2023. They've created a partnership with Chaffee County Health including plans to provide the agency with a seat on the board. Chaffee Shuttle assisted Bustang three times last month in different capacities.

B. Land Use Code Update

Garwood reported that multimodal and broadband issues are becoming increasingly important and would be addressed early in the new subdivision application process.

VI. New Business

A. Biking, Walking and Trail Funding Best Practices for 2023 - Donna Rhoads & Bonnie Davis

Rhoads and Davis attended the webinar regarding funding for various types of trails and potential applications for Chaffee County

B. Safe Routes to School Webinar - Donna Rhoads

Rhoads reported on the webinar and the unique ways some communities were addressing safe routes for their school-aged population. The most interesting was the manner in which the City of Center, CO, had developed its program.

C. 2023 TAB Meeting Schedule

Garwood provided a proposed meeting schedule for the TAB for 2023. Generally, the TAB would be meeting the second Thursday each month. It was agreed to accept the schedule and provide a copy to the County Administration Department.

VII. Other Business

TAB Board – JoAnne Allen is stepping down. There are three people who would like to join the TAB Board.
